## Characters

As it may have been noted, in Ardfel and the surrounding Shizen Race territories, surnames are spoken first formally, and so names have been categorized here by surname then given name.

***Ai Ryuuen*** – Midori Yama Mori Village Elder; Mahotsukai

***Hikari Junsui*** – *Yuki’s Mother (Deceased)*

***Hikari Juyo*** – Father of Yuki; Shinsei High Council leader; from Ran no Nawabari (Land of Orchids)

***Hikari (Kojiro) Yuki*** – Son (Maigo no Musuko)(Lost Son) of Junsui and Juyo; Mahotsukai (Adept Mage); Shinsei no Sora (Blessed of the Heavens); born in Kana prefecture (Ardfel); Midori Yama Mori (Green Mountain Forest) thereafter.

***Iyashii Kenryoku*** – Akurei Majutsushi from Majutsu no Ketsueki

***Kanashimi Akui*** – Lord of the Kana Prefecture; Presumed elder brother of Yuki.

***Kanashimi Kiseichi*** – *Former Lord of the Kana Prefecture; Presumed Father of Yuki (Deceased)*

***Kanashimi Tsurai*** – *Lord of Kana; Younger brother of Akui, presumed elder brother of Yuki (Deceased)*

***Kojiro Hana*** – *Keiji’s Foster Mother (Deceased)*

***Kojiro Keiji*** – The Hoshi no Ryu; Foster Son of Kojiro Hana; from Midori Yama Mori (Green Mountain Forest)

***Kozoku Inuoe*** – Crown Prince of Ardfel; son of Leuoe

***Kozoku Leuoe*** – *King of Ardfel (Deceased - Murdered)*

***Mamoru Kodai*** – Knight of Kana

***Mamoru Jujun*** – Granddaughter of Kodai, Sister of Saya

*Mamoru Saya* – Granddaughter of Kodai, Sister of Jujun

*Murasaki Tohru* – Great Grandson of Mamoru Kodai and Murasaki Sumire

*Murasaki Sumire* – Head Mistress Kanashimi Keep

*Ryu Akai* = Keiji's Father; Ruby-Gold Dragon; Immortal

*Ryu Aoi* = Keiji's Mother; Sapphire-Silver Dragon; Immortal

*Tetsuya* = Keiji's name in a tragic past life.

*Yamataki Yusuke* – Innkeeper Midori Inn, Midori no Yama

*Yogore Ijiwaru* – Viscount of Kana, Akurei Mahotsukai; from Unknown origins

## Name and Place Definitions
